

Ryan Dunn (Virginia at Georgia Tech 1/20/2024) – Live

Ryan showcased exceptional activity on the offensive glass pulling down 5 resulting in two putback buckets, demonstrating his ability to capitalize on second-chance opportunities. While he primarily operated in the paint, Dunn remained efficient, going a perfect 4-4 from the field. His scoring contributions included two layups, a dunk, and a push shot executed within pick-and-roll actions, highlighting his effectiveness in finishing around the rim.

Defensively, Dunn displayed remarkable versatility and engagement throughout the game. He exhibited the ability to guard players across all positions, seamlessly switching assignments and providing coverage from the perimeter to the interior. Additionally, Dunn showcased his shot-blocking ability both as a help-side defender and when contesting shots on-ball. His defensive versatility and shot-blocking ability were key components of his overall defensive impact.

One area to focus on could be expanding his offensive game beyond the paint, potentially developing a consistent mid-range or perimeter shot to increase his scoring versatility. Defensively, maintaining consistency and refining defensive techniques, such as positioning and footwork, could further solidify his impact on that end of the floor.
