

Michael DeVoe (Film: March 19, 2020, vs Loyola Chicago)

DeVoe started out this game strong against the #1 ranked defense in the nation. During a seven-minute stretch in the 1st half from 17:35-10:44 DeVoe posted 7 Pts, 2 Stl, 1 Ast and 2 Reb while going 3-3 from the field. Defensively his two steals generated easy offensive for the Yellow Jackets with the first leading to DeVoe's only made 3PT attempt and the second an easy finish at the rim for the senior guard.

In the 2nd half DeVoe was less effective as he failed to score until there was only 2:41 left in the game with a layup and converting another And-1 at the rim. He missed both of his 3PT attempts in the second half but managed to post two more assist highlighted by a dunk he assisted on while out on the break.

Defensively, DeVoe remains an opportunistic guard who looks to disrupt passing lanes. He is an average on ball and help defender who is usually in the right spot, rotates and contest shots.

Despite only going 1-3 from behind the arc, DeVoe remains his best on offense. Able to create his own shot at the rim or pulling up for a jump shot. In this game he showed a willingness to take what the defense gives in attempting multiple midrange shots when run off the three-point line. Lastly, DeVoe showcased an ability to keep teammates involved and does not hijack the offense. He was 2nd in field goal attempts with 10 for the Yellow Jackets but still led the team in assist with 4.
