

PJ Hall (11/15/21 vs Bryant)

Hall continued to show activity and increased chemistry with his teammates in the 93-70 win over Bryant. Hall didn't attempt a three in this contest but did contribute to the big win on 53.8% shooting from the field. Hall also collected five rebounds and 1 block showing his great length and defensive rotation for a big.

Offensively, he finished with 14 points; he scored 8 of the first 12 points for the Tigers. Clemson definitely looked to run action through him utilizing his size and skill set as a passer and shooter. Late in the first half, Hall used his size to see over the top of the defense as he found Tyson Hunter cutting backdoor on the baseline for a reverse layup.

Defensively, he gave consistent effort and used his length to block a shot on a three-point attempt. He did get blown by on two separate occasions due to closing out too high, which led to easy layups for Bryants. He has to use his length better as he did on the blocked three-point attempt, chop his feet and keep his hands high to avoid getting blown by.
