

Josh Anderson (Film: 12-19-20 vs. Alabama)

He was very hesitant offensively to start the game. Anderson made a strong righty drive coming out of the 2nd half that he should have relied on more often. In transition, he can fill the lanes and finish at the rim with contact; he had a momentum-shifting dunk in the 2nd half.

He has a good build as his long frame helps him on the defensive end. Anderson hustles back on defense and gets rewarded with a block he pinned against the glass. He has the leaping ability to translate to the next level. He contributed on the defensive end with tough on-ball defense. He found opportunities to get in passing lanes and lead the break the other way.

Overall, this was not Anderson's better offensive performance. He was not efficient with 6 points on 3-10 shooting. He did contribute 3 steals on the defensive end. You could see a little bit of Derrick Jones Jr. in his game as he has the leaping ability without fully developing other offensive skills.

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
