

Jairus Hamilton (Film: 1-23-21 vs. Minnesota)

He started the game 3-3 from behind the 3pt line in Pick n Pop action. He recognized he had a mismatch on defense and went down to the post on a smaller defender, showed good footwork on the block, getting deep position, using a drop-step for a layup. He also showcased his ability to create off the dribble, effectively creating room to get off his jump shot.

Hamilton was very active on the defensive glass in this game. He finished the game with 4 defensive rebounds, which was close to his season high. He did struggle guarding on the perimeter, didn't move his feet well, and tended to reach and gamble instead of playing straight-up.

Overall, this was one of Hamilton's better performances of the season. He was instant offense for Maryland, who needed his 3pt shooting to space the floor. Hamilton tied his season-high with 15 points on an efficient 3-4 from 3-point.
