

David Collins (3/2/21 vs Memphis)

Offensively, Collins struggled off the tip due to Memphis's length, and defensive intensity made it hard for Collins to create for himself off the dribble. He didn't score until the second half when he drove into the lane, using a jump-stop and his footwork for a tough left-hand layup with contact. When Collins looks downhill, he tends to force the contact and rely on the official to call a foul. He attacked of reversals, drawing fouls but only making two of his eight free-throw attempts. Collins managed to score another time in the transition of a steal in transition.

Defensively, he made a nice defensive play in the opening minute on a basket rotation to block a layup; other than that play on the defensive end, he seemed to be disengaged overall. He was late on closeouts and had lazy feet when cutting off baseline drives.
