

Kihei Clark (Virginia) 5'9" 160 PG (Film 11/27/20)

Standing at 5 foot 9 inches Kihei Clark is one of the smaller guys in college basketball. He is an extremely quick guard with great vision and the ability to play with both hands.

San Francisco went under most ball screens for him. At 5 foot 9 he needs to be able to make them pay when defenses do not respect his shot. As a whole this was not one of his better games; he struggled on his drives when surrounded by length.

Defensively he is often able to stay in front of guys on drives. This allows the help-side defense to be able to block the shot at the rim. He got beat twice towards the end of the game by Jamaree Bouyea; once on a back cut and the other was a baseline drive. A couple times the guards just raised over him and knocked down some shots too.
