

Posh Alexander (St. John's) 6'0" 190 PG (Film 12/11/20 vs. Seton Hall)

A hometown kid from Brooklyn, New York is the starting point guard for St. John's. A smaller guard that pressures the ball with quick feet. He is the ideal guard for Mike Anderson who loves to play up-tempo.

It is tough to make a living as a 6 foot point guard (at best) that is not shooting the ball particularly well. Posh is shooting 25% on the season from 3 and missed his sole attempt today. St. John's does not have a whole lot of shooting as a whole which is not in favor of Posh since the lane is that much tighter than usual. In the half court he had one basket which was a rebound off an air-ball. He scored two baskets in transition which is where he will make a living with his speed. He displayed good body control on his two finishes. One he went into the chest of a Seton Hall big. He didn't distribute the ball all that well either as he forced a pass on a backdoor cut for a turnover. He also had a charge where he just lowered his shoulder into the on-ball defender.

On defense he is the ideal guard for this team. He pressures the ball full-court throughout the whole game. He moves his feet well and has over 20 steals on the season. He is a Gnat defensively that is just constantly annoying the offensive player. This is the side of the ball that he brings the most value.
