

Jared Rhoden (Seton Hall) 6'6" 210 SG/SF (Film 12/20/20 vs. Providence)

Rhoden played significantly better in this game than he did vs. St. John's. He played with way more confidence and competed. I believe being in foul trouble hindered him last time I saw him play. He scored 16 on 5/11 shooting but shot 0/4 from three.

He did not shoot the ball well from three, missing a couple open attempts. Outside of that he played well. He had a nice pull up where he elevated over the defender and knocked down a good shot. He moves off the ball well; he had two different cuts that led to him getting baskets. He had a pretty finger roll with his right hand on a drive to his left.

On defense he played well, you could really see he moves his feet well and his length bothers opposing players. He stayed with quick guards throughout the game. He works hard too, he was always on the glass. He had a good play where he came over and protected the rim by walling up.

In all this was definitely a better game than the last time I saw him. I do not love him for the NBA game. He has good length but is only 6'6" which is a smaller wing at the next level. If he were to make it, it would most likely be a 3 and D wing but he is only shooting the ball at 33%. I personally believe he is a better shooter than 33% but will need to see it. I do not see an NBA caliber wing right now.
