

**Ron Harper Jr.** (Rutgers) 6'6" 245 SG/SF (Film 1/9/21 vs. Ohio St.)

Harper Jr. had 11 points on 5/12 shooting and only shot 1 of 4 from three on the game. After his blazing hot start that was impossible to continue he has cooled off. In the last three games he is averaging just over 12 points and shooting just over 30 percent from three.

He hit a three and had a couple mid-range pull ups that were nice shots. He can obviously shoot the ball well but he missed a couple threes that he could have easily made. He struggled to get to the rim and beat people off the bounce. He did not really create separation on his own, most of his game came from his shooting ability with a solid pump fake.

On defense I was pleased with his ability to defend multiple positions. Harper Jr. was able to guard bigger guys in the post and use his strength to not get backed down. He was also able to defend on the perimeter well, using his length to contest shots after moving his feet to stay with the offensive player. He showed promising potential on the defensive side of the ball.

A lot of Ron Harper Jr.'s offensive game will be based on if he can hit shots or not. He missed a couple tonight but that happens. I was very pleased with him on the defensive side of the ball.
