

**Jaren Holmes** (St. Bonaventure) 6'4" 215 PG/SG (Film 1/23/21 vs. Duquesne)

Holmes has decent size and can play either guard position. Listed at 6'4" and is pretty built. He has good positional size. I would like him to be a little lighter as it seemed to slow him down a little bit. He is heavier than most guards in the NBA.

Offensively he struggled. He was 3/14 from the field and 0/5 from three. He finished with 8 points and 0 assists and 3 turnovers. He started at the 2 and moved to the 1 when Lofton was out of the game. He shot almost 40% from three on the season and his form looks solid so it leads me to believe he just had a bad game. He is shooting only 53% from the free throw line though.

Defensively he did a solid job, he seems to understand the game on that side of the floor. The team as a whole rotated on the weakside well and he was a part of that. He was not afraid to get on the floor for a loose ball or fight for a rebound. He rebounded excellently for a guard. He finished with 10 rebounds. It was nice to see someone who couldn't score and contribute in other ways on the floor.

Overall, he just did not jump out as an NBA guard for me. He did not score, shoot or pass all that well. I believe he has more to his game than I saw tonight but it was a poor performance for him.
