

## **Dillon Jones vs Northern Arizona 3/2/24 Film**

Dillon Jones exhibited the ability to have a feel for the game. He knows when to attack the rim and when he has a mismatch. On one play, he gets the smaller defender, goes right into the post, gets the ball in the R post, spins going baseline, dribbles and finishes at the rim with a layup for the And1. In addition, Jones demonstrated the ability to create for himself. On one play, he gets the ball inside the three point line on the L side of the basket, jabs step, two dribbles going R, bumps the defender and hits the mid range jump shot. In this game, he didn't shoot well from beyond the arc. He shot 0/3 from three points off a catch and shoot.

Jones displayed on-ball defender abilities. Something that stood out to me was how active he was on the defensive end. On one play, he picks up the roll man off PNR, closes out on the shot with hands in the air in a defensive stand, and beats his man to the spot that led to his man turning the ball over on the pass.

Dillon Jones showcased his offensive skills by his ability to attack the rim and recognize mismatches. Defensively, he showed promise as an on-ball defender with his activity and ability to contest the shot. However, an area of improvement for Jones would be his shot from beyond the arc, as he struggled in this game shooting 0/3.
