Kennedy Chandler (November 20,2021, vs Villanova Wildcats)

In this game, Kennedy Chandler struggled in the first half. He wasn't aggressive and was playing off the ball rather than operating as the ball-handler. In the second half, he was more aggressive attacking the rim and operating as the primary ball-handler. When attacking the rim, he was able to use his speed to blow by defenders and get straight line drives. Chandler struggled to finish against Villanova Wildcats' length and size around the rim, which allowed the Wildcats to alter many shots at the rim. Chandler showed a lack of footwork and craftiness when attacking the rim. He also lacked poise, body control, and rushed many shots at the rim. A play in this game of Chandler attacking the rim was with 3:19 minutes left in the first half. He used his first quick step to blow by Justin Moore and rushed the layup at the rim on the straight-line drive.

When playmaking, Chandler was able to find the open man but struggled to make passes against length. When matched up against length, it was either a turnover or a tough pass to handle for the player receiving the ball. When he attacked the rim, he was looking to shoot rather than being playmaker off dribble penetration. He could have gotten his teammates better looks off dribble penetration rather than going for the tough layup at the rim.
