

Jordon Hall # (Live 3/2/2022 vs LaSalle)

In this game Jordon Hall played very well. He can get a lot of rebounds for a guard which surprised me. Hall can do everything on the court from shooting the 3pt as well as hitting mid-range jump shots. He also passed the ball extremely well which led him to get 5 assists. Hall had 10 pts in the first half but then began to struggle with scoring in the second where he only had 2 points. Overall, I really was impressed with his play style since he can do anything on the court. Hall is definitely St. Joseph's main guy on the floor, the only real issue I saw in this game was his turnovers, if he can bring these down, he can be a great player.

Jordon Hall finished the game shooting 2-6 at the 3pt and 5-14 at the FG. He also had 13 REB, 5 AST, 2 STL, 6 TO and 12 PTS.
